About OSC School

OSCS is a system of education designed for children who cannot take admission in regular schools due to financial constraints or being above age. Here one year's course is covered in 6 months. Children are prepared to enter main stream education. Starting with 20 students now OSCS F-11 branch has more than 170 students and four other branches.

New Branch in Tarnol Islamabad

Abrar free education foundation constructed a school building near a farm in Tarnol providing a beautiful environment for quality education for the poor children living in its vicinity. OSCS was asked to offer educational assistance and so we are happy to announce the opening of our Tarnol branch w.e.f. 1st October 2012. Apart from the regular morning school, adult educational program is offered in the afternoon. In the evening around 200 students of nearby schools are provided free educational assistance. In May 2013, Taleem al Quran course shall also be offered for ladies living in this area.

OSCS Collaborates with NCPC

In May 2012, collaboration was started with NCPC (National Child Protection Center), a subordinate office of Ministry of Human Rights, who bring children from slum areas to their center located in H-9. Previously UNESCO was providing teachers to these children but when UNESCO authorities withdrew the facility, children lost the initiative to come to the center. This came to our knowledge and we established a branch here. Today these children are disciplined and show an urge to learn and excel in education.

OSCS setup in DHA Lahore

In July 2012 a new branch of OSCS was set up in Lahore DHA. A motivated team of volunteers with a sound educational experience started working in a slum area near LUMS. The upper portion of a house was rented, white washed and furnished. Local teachers have been hired and are serving full time in the branch.

“No good deeds done on other days are superior to those done on these (first ten days of Dhal Hajja).” Then some companions of the Prophet said, “Not even Jihad?” He replied, “Not even Jihad”, except that of a man who does it by putting himself and his property in danger (for Allah’s sake) and does not return with any of those things.”(Bukhari 15: 86)

Exams and Result day

Result day is a happy occasion which is looked forward to, by most of the students.

At OSCS F-11, 145 students appeared in the exams out of which 125 passed and were promoted to the next class. Students of Tarnol branch showed much better results and apart from 2 students, all were promoted to the next class. At OSCS H-9 Branch a total of 61 students of Playgroup, Nursery and K.G. sat for the examination. 51 out of 61 students were promoted and 10 students were retained in their existing classes. First promotion exams also took place in Lahore Branch and good results were recorded.

All the parents were gratified that their children were getting quality education, completely free of cost.

Zul Hajj Activities

OSCS students learnt about the importance of the first ten days of Zul Hajj before the start of this month and were motivated to do as many good deeds as possible.

Due to shortage of space Nursery and K.G. classes have a different Salah time during which they also learn how to read and recite Arabic text. They are also taught concepts of Tawheed, Ahadith in Arabic and Seerah of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. They are rewarded for arranging their shoes and good seating mannerism. These sessions have helped children in improving quality of Salah

Seerah Workshop—Prophet ﷺ and Children

A class on Husne Akhlaaq is held for teachers at OSCS F-11 every Friday. The topic of the class on 9th February was **“Affection with Children”**; so a combined session was arranged where students were present as well. They were thrilled to hear how Prophet ﷺ used to treat children; and were especially amazed to hear a hadith that once Prophet ﷺ touched the cheeks of all the children around him ﷺ and the child narrating the hadith remembered the fragrance of

his ﷺ hand even at an older age. Students were also told how Prophet ﷺ treated his daughter Fatima RA whenever she came to meet him; how he used to stand and greet her; hold her hand and make her sit at his place; and how Fatima RA used to do the same for Prophet ﷺ. Students were asked to treat their parents the same way. They were really excited by this activity and were eager to share all these new found facts with their siblings and family

Jaabir bin Samurah – a young child – narrated that he prayed Dhuhr with the Prophet (saw) in the masjid. He said that Rasool (saw) went to his house and he went with him. As the Prophet (saw) was walking, he would wipe his hands on the cheeks of the kids passing by.
